ENVIRONNEMENT

EMPTYING SEPTIC SYSTEMS

We remind you that the provincial regulations (Q-2, r.22) on the disposal and treatment of wastewater from isolated dwellings requires the owner of a building to drain the septic tank every 2 years for annual occupancy and every 4 years for seasonal occupation. For this purpose, you must choose an accredited business by the Municipality.

PUBLIC WORKS

SNOW DISPOSAL

To facilitate snow removal operations, it is strictly forbidden to dispose of snow or ice in the ditches, highways or other public places. This regulation is in place to avoid any issues related to snowmelt. Municipality of Cantley will issue fines of around \$ 200 for a first offense and \$ 1,000 for any subsequent offense, and as same, for each day the offense continues, according to Regulation 12-RM-04.

NEW RESIDUAL MATERIALS COLLECTION

Since January 1st, 2019, the Municipality of Cantley has modified waste management to meet the provincial government's waste reduction objectives. In particular, it introduces the collection of compostable materials, changes the timetable and mechanizes collection, which implies:

- Use of compliant bins (recycling, compostable materials and waste),
- the specific arrangement of the bins at the roadside.

FIRE DEPARTMENT

OUTDOORS FIRES

Small fires $(1m \times 1m)$ do not require a permit and are allowed every day of the week, from 6 p.m. to 1 a.m., and during weekends and holidays, from 8 a.m. to 1 a.m.

Large fires (more than 1m in circumference) require a permit. They are allowed form November 1st to April 30th. Permits are free and are available at the Municipality or by visiting our website.

Before starting your fire, see conditions such as clearance, permitted materials, provincial bans, wind speed and other details. Details available on the Municipality's website as per by-law 16-RM-05 (491-16).

ARE YOU READY IN CASE OF EMERGENCY?

It is important to be prepared for potential emergencies or disasters.

Preparing properly requires knowing what risks you may face. In Cantley, as in all of Quebec, we are exposed to a range of hazards, including accidents involving hazardous materials, ice storm, snowstorm, fire, flood, power outage, earthquake, high winds, tornado, etc.

Prepare to be self-sufficient for at least 72 hours.

This is the amount of time rescue teams could take to assist you or would be required to reestablish services. You will need some essential items to support your basic needs during this period. Keep in mind that you may need to manage without an energy source or running water.


PREVENTION HOME VISITS

The Service des incendies et des premiers répondants (Fire Department and First Responders) plan to conduct approximately 550 home visits in 2019 to verify, among other things, smoke and carbon monoxide alarms. The objectives of the residential visit program are to:

- promote preventive action to eliminate the risk of home fires;
- promote municipal fire regulation;
- conduct data collection to identify risks that firefighters may face.

All dog owners must acquire an annual licence that will be valid from January 1st to December 31st of each year at a cost of \$20 for each dog. This medallion makes it easier to find our hairy friends if they get lost.

PROPERTY VALUES

The three-year roll of the Municipality of Cantley for years 2019, 2020 and 2021, has been lodged at directeur général et secrétaire-trésorier's office. Any person can take note at this place during regular opening hours. As required in section 74 of the Municipal Taxation Act, a notice has also been given that any person with an interest, can lodge a request for review (of the roll) under section 1 of Chapter X of that Act. 2019 BUDGET

The 2019 municipal budget is in the spirit of rigour and continuity, with projected revenues totalling \$15,160,235, of which more than 80% comes from taxes, an increase of 5.4% over last vear.

The general municipal property tax rate, whether residential or not, does not increase in 2019 for the 6th consecutive year.


The increase, if any, that appears in the tax account is a result of the triennial review of the role required by the provincial government (see "Property values").

The Municipality has set various objectives in order to establish this balanced budget:

- Optimize revenues by respecting taxpayers' ability to pay;
- Specify and develop the supply of public services at affordable costs:
- Maximize public investments (road infrastructure, buildings, vehicle fleet, parks).

The three-year 2019-2021 program includes investments in 2019 of more than \$24 million in various municipal capital assets, including:

- Community Centre (MCC),
- \$ \$5.5 million for a new fire hall (upon grants obtention).
- ♥ Nearly 800,000 for the development of municipal parks,
- ♥ over \$9.6 million for the rehabilitation of municipal roads (including municipal and regional bike lanes).



The Municipality of Cantley maintains its growth both in terms of population and investments, as reflected in this budget, which is both conservative in terms of its revenues and ambitious in terms of the many development projects.

SUBSIDY PROGRAM

Aquatic program: Upon presentation of proof of residence and the invoice for the aguatic course, the Municipality reimburses \$75 per person for the current year.

Reusable diapers program: The municipality reimburses \$100 for the purchase of a minimum of 20 washable diapers. The application form must be accompanied by proof of residence, proof of the child's date of birth and original invoices.
